Ask Your Career Tech Counselor:

Q: EVERYBODY IS TALKING ABOUT GPA. WHY IS HAVING A MINIMUM 3.0 GPA SUCH A BIG DEAL?

- A: A 3.0 GPA is the door to several opportunities
- A 3.0 GPA is required to be eligible for Dual Credit classes. Taking Dual Credit classes in high school can enrich your high school experience, help you be better prepared to be a full-time college student, and jump start your college degree.
- A 3.0 minimum GPA is required for honors, high honors, distinguished endorsement.
- A 3.0 GPA earns a 1/2 tuition scholarship at MGCCC. A 3.5 earns full tuition

IMPORTANT OCTOBER REMINDERS:

- 1) ACT on Oct 23. Get a good night's sleep. Eat a high protein breakfast. Bring pencils and a calculator (see Ms. Wease or Mrs. Maddox if you don't have a calculator), Arrive early. Bring a protein snack and drink for break. Be awesome!
- 2) October is FAFSA month. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid applications opens on Oct 1. Seniors should apply early!
