## Health and Wellness Fair 2022

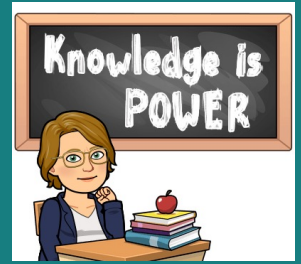
