The Automotive Service Technology program is designed to provide students with an understanding of the complex systems of today's technology in the automotive service industry. Students receive instruction in safety, brakes, steering, suspensions, ignition systems, tune-ups, fuel systems, emission controls, transmissions, drive trains, and basic automotive service.

The two-year program prepares students for entry-level positions in the automotive repair and service industry or a post-secondary Automotive Technology Program.

CORE SUBJECTS

Math, English, and Chemistry are imbedded in the curriculum for this program.

CERTIFICATES may be earned by passing comprehensive post exams.


